

BodyShape Tape™

This single sided medical grade adhesive tape is made with a very strong adhesive that is designed to keep the tape in place under a variety of conditions. Please be sure where you want tape to adhere before removing protective liner. Wherever this tape touches, it will usually adhere. Use with caution around eyes! Tape will work best in shaved areas.

Using Body Shape Tape- Cleavage. Without using tape, experiment in front of a mirror. Use your hands to move your chest flesh to create cleavage and look you are seeking. It is best if you use your right hand to move flesh on your left side and visa versa. When you are satisfied that you know where you want flesh moved, the protective liner is removed from the tape. About half the length of tape is attached to the area being moved. Use one hand to push the area to be moved into position rather than pulling it with the tape. Once flesh is in place, attach. These steps are repeated for other side of chest. Tape from one side of your chest may be attached over tape from the other side.

- Some clients have found it easier to just remove the protective liner on the tape half way (fold it back). After positioning the breast tissue, they then slide the remaining protective liner off the tape and attach this half to chest.
- If you have sensitive nipples you may wish to avoid placing tape over them. Covering sensitive nipples with a small pad will allow you to use BodyShape Tape.
- Do not pull flesh so tight that you will be uncomfortable

Using Body Shape Tape-Necks and Chins. Tape is applied to each side of neck & pulled back until desired result is reached. Application of tape is best in an area that will be hidden by clothing, hair, or wig, when the tape is drawn back.

Thighs, bottoms, etc. As with cleavage creation above, it is best to experiment without tape first. More than one strip of tape may be needed for larger areas.

Using Body Shape Tape- For clothing and repairs. The tape adheres to most materials. When using on plastic, vinyl or leather clothing, check for color fastness first.

Removal of Body Shape Tape. Removal is quite simple and painless. A little Baby Oil, or other body oil, is applied to sticky side of tape during removal. Do not attempt to remove BodyShape Tape without applying baby oil or other body oil.

Repairs to Silicone Breast Forms. If silicone has leaked from forms, clean area around tear in breast form of all silicone. Wipe with alcohol. Cut a piece of tape that is about 1" longer on each end than the damaged area. Cut desired length of tape, allowing for about 1" from ends of cut. Close tear and apply tape. It is best if someone is available to help with this as tape cannot be removed after coming in contact with breast form. A second layer of tape can be applied.

Do not use Body Shape Tape to attach breast enhancers, breast forms or other applications where removal of the tape may damage the item the tape was applied to.

Do not apply BodyShape Tape to genitalia

Important: In rare cases, users may have a reaction to the use of body adhesives. Should redness occur on your skin, it is advisable to discontinue use of tape until redness disappears. Should redness remain for an extended period, or reoccur with subsequent use of tape, discontinue use of the tape. If you have allergies to adhesives, it may be advisable to do a test with a very small amount of tape.
